**Huawni Legacy Rewards**

For each new camper recruited, you earn reward points or 'pine cones.'

- › One camper week equals one pine cone; one camper recruited for a two-week session equals 2 pine cones. (For example, recruiting 10 two-week campers will equal 20 camper weeks or 20 pine cones.)
- › To be an eligible recruit, the camper must be first timer at Huawni.

**PINE CONE REWARDS:**

- » **5 pine cones** for a \$250 credit toward your child's tuition to Huawni (or donate a scholarship to the Camp Huawni Alumni Association). There is no limit on how many of these can be exchanged.
- » **5 pine cones** for a \$250 gift certificate to Del Frisco's in Fort Worth, Dallas, or Houston.
- » **10 pine cones** for a weekend package to a Texas located hotel or resort such as Fort Worth Omni, Hyatt Regency Hill Country, or Hyatt Regency Lost Pines.
